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Post-Operative Instructions - ACL RECONSTRUCTION

YOU MUST USE YOUR CRUTCHES UNTIL SEEN BY YOUR SURGEON AT YOUR 1ST POST-OP VISIT

- Patient must wear brace at all times
 - a. Brace should be set at 0 degrees until 1st post-op visit
 - b. At 1st post-op visit brace will be set at 0-30 degrees
- Patients are allowed to shower the day after surgery (if no drains or pain catheter) with no submerging of wound until 3-4 weeks after surgery
 - a. Shower only
 - b. Wait 24 hours after drain is pulled (if used) to shower
- Wound to be covered at all times with Band-Aids, except while showering. Remove Band-Aids before showering. Allow wound to air dry. Re-apply new Band-Aids.
- No ointments, lotions or patches are to be applied to wound
- 1st post-op appointment will be the day after surgery or 1st day clinic is open after surgery
 - a. Dressing change and skin inspection
 - b. Review of pictures and procedure performed
 - c. If Lateral Release (remove drain)
 - 1. If it is over the weekend patient will remove drain
 - d. 1st physical therapy appointment will be scheduled for you
- 2nd post-op appointment will be 7-10 days after surgery
 - a. Remove sutures
 - b. Apply Steri-Strips
- Weight bearing will be as follows:
 - a. 25% with crutches 1st day
 - b. Progress as tolerated to full weight bearing
 - c. May discontinue crutches when patient is not limping (about 10-14 days)
- Icing
 - a. Days 1 & 2: 20 minutes every hour
 - b. Day 3: 10 20 minutes as needed
